- 1. NO alcohol or drugs at camp site.
- 2. NO youth under 4-H age will be allowed at the camp.
- 3. Girls are not allowed in the boys cabin, boys are not allowed in the girls cabin.
- 4. Counselors are expected to assist with activities, participate in the operation of the camp and supervise the members from their county.

- 6. If severe homesickness prevails, parents will be contacted with the camper being sent home.
- 7. If rules are broken, member will be sent home at their own expense.
